CONCEPT NOTE

Association Internationale des Professeurs de Philosophie e.V. (<https://www.aipph.org/index.php/de/>). Founded 1 Nov 1964, in Sèvres (France), as *International Committee on the Teaching of Philosophy – Comité international de l'enseignement philosophique*, at the 3rd International Congress on the Teaching of Philosophy in European Secondary Schools. New Statutes and present name adopted at 5th International Congress on the Teaching of Philosophy in European Secondary Schools, in 1971, Brussels (Belgium). Registered in accordance with Belgian law, in 1974. Newly registered in accordance with German law, in 2020.

Its aims are: to promote the teaching of philosophy in schools and universities of member countries; provide information on philosophy teaching in Europe; to ensure that philosophy teaching is based on the fundamental condition of freedom of thought and expression; to ensure that working conditions for philosophy teaching guarantee its free and effective development; and finally to promote cooperation of national associations concerned with philosophy teaching with regard to the formation and implementation of the Association's aims.
